Types of odors: Two aids of each of the following "main" odors must be placed out to search; marijuana herion,cocaine, methamphetamine for a total of eight (8) aids. The remaining two (2) aids placed out to search are any odor per discretion of the instructor.

Training Aid requirements: At least two one gram or less. At least one located one foot in depth from dog. At least one a minimum three feet or higher than dog. At least one over three pounds or one ounce of hard drugs.

Search Requirements: Four automobiles within twenty minutes or two automobiles and one bus. Any combination of blanks or none at all during vehicle searches may be run. One exterior search of a buried aid along a fence, building foundation etc. Interior room can be any amount or size with a minimum of 2 blanks.

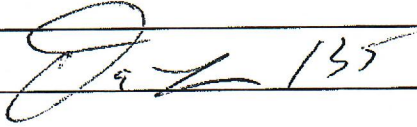

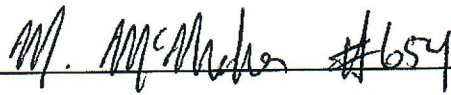
